APPLY FOR A FOREIGN LANGUAGE & AREA STUDIES (FLAS) AWARD

Did you know that the U.S. Department of Education funds Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) fellowships for students to learn world languages and area studies? Apply through the University of Wisconsin-Madison!

ELIGIBILITY

Students must be:

- U.S. citizens, nationals, or permanent residents
- Enrolled full-time in a UW-Madison degree program

Undergraduate students must be at the intermediate or advanced level of study of a less commonly taught language.

Graduate students must be at the intermediate or advanced level of language study (or have advanced proficiency in another language related to their field to qualify for first year language study).
